

DEPED CALAPAN CITY DOMINATES 2023 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

WRITE AND WIN. Student scribes from different schools in Calapan City proved that they will not just write, but win as they successfully conquered the 2023 Regional Schools Press Conference held in Tagaytay last June 10-12.

This 16th of June, the delegates led by Mr. Joey B. Gutierrez, together with City Education Officer Myriam Olalia, presented the awards they recieved to City Mayor Marlou Flores-Morillo at the Executive Conference, City Hall of Calapan.

With 109 recognitions plus 19 special awards in group categories, the Department of Education Calapan City came in as the Champion of 2023 RSPC.

On top of these, 15 student journalists are qualified to compete on the Individual Contests of the upcoming National Schools Press Conference - 6 elementary students and 9 secondary students.

Meanwhile for the Group Category, the Collaborative Desktop Publishing (English) Team of Adriatico Memorial School, TV Broadcasting

(both English and Filipino Category) and Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting Team of Oriental Mindoro High School, Online Publishing (English) Team of Oriental Mindoro High School, and Online Publishing (Filipino) of Divine Word College of Calapan were also set to compete on the 2023 NSPC.

2023 National Schools Press Conference is set to be hosted by Cagayan de Oro from July 17 - 21, 2023.

The teachers and student journalists also took the opportunity to extend their appreciation to the support given by the City Government of Calapan.

For years, Calapan City is one of the cities who leads the MIMAROPA Region in the field of campus journalism as DepEd Calapan produces exemplary and competitive student journalists (Thea Marie J. Villadolid/ CIO).

MAHIGIT 1,800 na mga informal fisherfolks sa Calapan na naapektuhan ng oil spill tragedy ang nakatanggap ng ayuda mula sa Emergency Cash Transfer (ECT) ng Department of Social Welfare and Development, ika-17 ng Hunyo sa Barangay SMV.

Isa ang ECT sa mga emergency o disaster response ng DSWD na naglalayong matulungan ang mga
